Five simple ways to help get your child ready to read:

- **Talking:** Children learn language & other early literacy skills by listening to their parents and others talk.
- **Singing:** Singing slows down language so children can hear the different sounds that make up words.
- **Reading:** Reading together increases vocabulary and general knowledge. Read every day!
- **Writing:** Children learn pre-reading skills through writing activities. Writing begins with scribbles so keep crayons and paper available.
- **Playing:** Play helps children express themselves & put thoughts into words. Unstructured play encourages children to use their imaginations and create stories about what they are doing.
